 - ii. key qualifications of the Company, including detail of its track record and experience in delivering similar services to the Tug Services intended to be

provided under the Proposed Contract, and any relevant supporting information.

- b) Detailed documentation to evidence the Company's ability to comply with Appendix 1;
- c) Details of the tugs that you propose would be deployed under the Proposed Contract and would provide the Tug Services, pursuant to Appendix 3; and
- d) Details of the Company's proposed rates that will be payable by customers and third parties in relation to the provision of the Tug Services.

The information supplied in the Company's tender should be sufficiently detailed in order to allow ABP to make an informed assessment of the Company's ability to provide the Tug Services.

- c) capability to deliver the Tug Services and wider capabilities to deliver additional services; including the ability to meet the tug specification provided in Appendix 3 of the proposed form of contract.

Once ABP has reached a decision in respect of the award of the Proposed Contract, it will notify all parties who have submitted proposals of that decision. ABP will not be obliged to discuss reasons for declining any tender in respect of the Proposed Contract.
