ADVICE FOR LEISURE CRAFT REGARDING EASING OF COVID-19 RESPONSE RESTRICTIONS

MARINERS AND OWNERS ARE HEREBY ADVISED that the Government has now indicated that all forms of water sport are able to recommence (where the relevant COVID-19 guidance on social distancing can be followed).

For leisure vessels in England no more than two people (or one household) may use a vessel and social distancing rules of two metres spacing continue to apply.

Subject to ongoing clarification and any further change in guidance from the Government, the Humber Estuary is maintaining its statutory open port policy by continuing to facilitate commercial and now leisure vessels that comply with the COVID-19 restrictions.

MARINERS AND OWNERS ARE ADVISED to check with their local Marina or mooring provider to check for local access or use restrictions. If you are planning to take your vessel out please make extra effort to ensure that all maintenance and pre-season checks are completed to avoid unnecessary additional strain on emergency services.

MARINERS AND OWNERS ARE FURTHER ADVISED that the Police have issued fines to individuals not adhering to the law on social distancing or public gatherings which apply to these settings.
