

# **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

### No. H. 88/2020

## RIVER TRENT

### **MESSINGHAM - EXPOSED GAS PIPES**

**MARINERS ARE WARNED** that a survey carried out on the 16<sup>th</sup> June 2020 shows the following: -

Two gas pipelines (which are normally buried) have become exposed above the river bed in the vicinity of Messingham, approximately 1800 metres upstream of West Butterwick, in the following position:

- 53° 31.576 N, 00° 44.266 W (WGS84)

A least depth of 1.7 metres below Chart Datum exists to the Western side of the river.

Deeper water exists to the Eastern side of the river in this vicinity.

**MARINERS ARE ADVISED** that works to re-bury the pipes will be carried out as soon as is practicable.

**MARINERS ARE REQUIRED** to navigate with caution and **not anchor** in the vicinity of the gas pipes.
