### **ALEXANDRA DOCK, HULL – WERNER QUAY STONE BED INSTALLATION OPERATIONS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that commencing on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> December 2024 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) for a period of approximately eight weeks, stone bed installation works will be conducted in the vicinity of Werner Quay, Alexandra Dock, Hull.
