RIVER TRENT

MESSINGHAM - EXPOSED GAS PIPES

MARINERS ARE WARNED that a survey carried out on the 9th January 2021 shows the following: -

Two gas pipelines (which are normally buried) have become exposed above the river bed in the vicinity of Messingham, approximately 1800 metres upstream of West Butterwick, in the following position:

- 53° 31.576 N, 00° 44.266 W (WGS84)

Depths over the exposed areas are 0.3 metres below Chart Datum at the Western side of the river and 1.7 metres below Chart Datum Mid-river.

Deeper water exists to the Eastern side of the river in this vicinity.

MARINERS ARE REQUIRED to navigate with caution and **not anchor** in the vicinity of the gas pipes.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that works to re-bury the pipes will be carried out as soon as is practicable. In addition, Notice to Mariners No. H. 88/2020 is hereby cancelled.
