SCHEDULED REPAIR WORKS TO SPURN JETTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Sunday 17th October 2021 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of approximately five days, scheduled repair works will commence at Spurn jetty.

The 36-metre workboat '**REBECCA M**' (call sign MSMC7) will be engaged in the works which will take place during daylight hours only.

The '**REBECCA M**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16 and 12.

The repair works will be undertaken during daylight hours only and VTS will advise via broadcast on VHF CH. 12 when works are underway and completed each day.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to pass at slow speed to avoid creating a wash when works are being carried out.
