### RESTRICTIONS ON SHORE LEAVE FOR VISITING SHIPS

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that all arriving vessels are reminded that due to levels of COVID 19 infection, the UK remains in national lockdown. All crew shore leave should be restricted to essential reasons only in line with UK government advice.

In addition, all ship's crew on vessels bound from **Portugal** should remain onboard until their 10-day quarantine period has passed and may only step ashore to carry out essential operational tasks (such as checking draught marks).

The standard protocols described in Local Notice to Mariners H.39/2020 regarding the medical declaration of health should continue to be strictly adhered to.
