RIVER HUMBER – EAST OF IMMINGHAM DOCK
SURVEY OPERATIONS

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on Tuesday 25th March 2025 (or as soon after as circumstances permit), survey operations will be conducted in the vicinity of Immingham Dock and the Immingham Oil Terminal as follows:

The 6-metre work boat '**COASTAL SENSOR**' will be engaged in bathymetric survey works to retrieve survey data and will be kept clear of commercial traffic at all times.

The works are scheduled to be undertaken during daylight hours only and the '**COASTAL SENSOR**' will inform VTS and Immingham Dock on commencement and completion of the works.

VTS and Immingham Dock will liaise with the '**COASTAL SENSOR**' to inform them of any vessels intending to navigate in the vicinity of the works in good time.

The '**COASTAL SENSOR**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 69, 68, 16, and 12.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area and to give the '**COASTAL SENSOR**' as wide a berth as possible, passing at the slow speed to avoid creating a wash.
