GRIMSBY MIDDLE - SHOAL WATER

MARINERS ARE WARNED that a survey carried out on the 29th March 2022 shows the following: -

 Depths of less than 6.4 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 50 metres into the Southern edge of the navigation channel from 600 metres upstream of the No. 4A Clee Ness Light Float to 200 metres downstream of the No. 4B Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the North in this vicinity.

 Depths of less than 6.4 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 35 metres into the Southern edge of the navigation channel from 350 metres to 610 metres downstream of the No. 8 Middle Burcom Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the North in this vicinity.
