STALLINGBOROUGH FLATS ENVIRONMENTAL SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Friday 26 April (or as soon as circumstances permit) for a period of approximately 4 days, during daylight hours only, there will be several small-scale water sampling and trawl operations between the Upper Burcom and Sunk Spit.

The 18-metre survey vessel '**HUMBER GUARDIAN**' (call sign 2ENC3) will be engaged in the operations and will contact VTS Humber on commencement and completion of each operation to ensure commercial traffic is not impeded.

The '**HUMBER GUARDIAN**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 12 and 16.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to exercise care and caution when navigating in the area.
