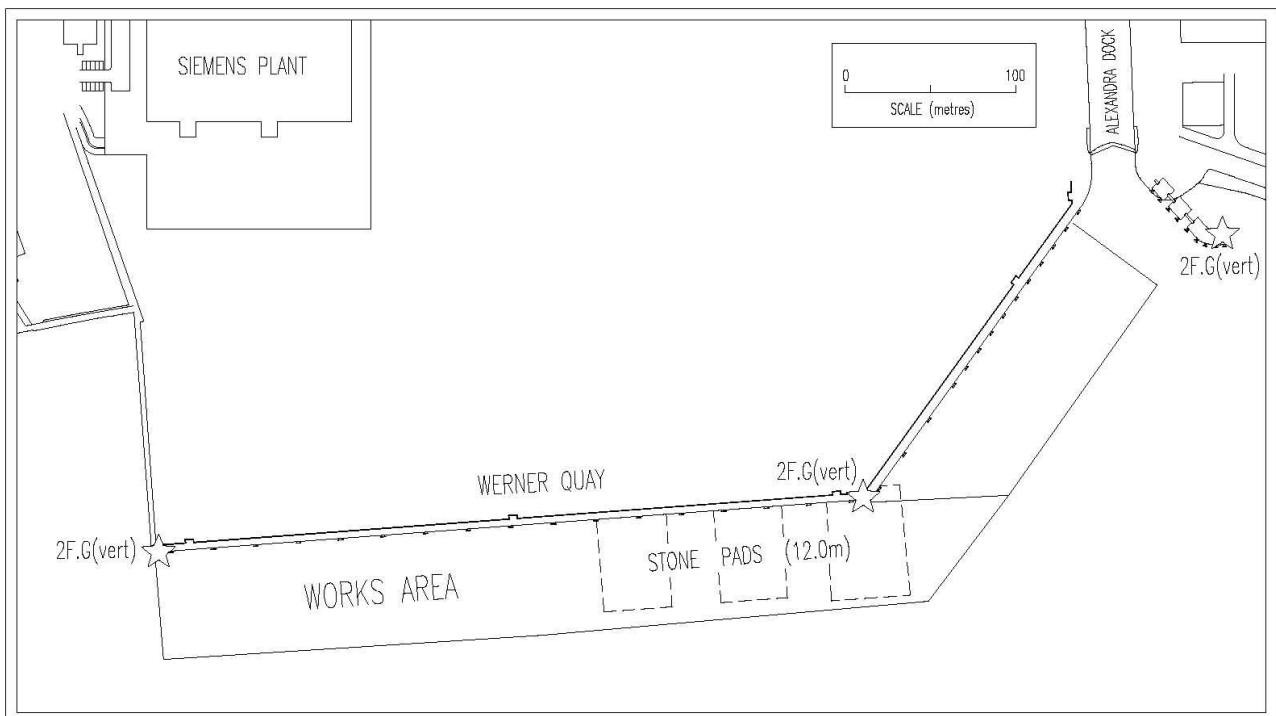

## RIVER HUMBER

### ALEXANDRA DOCK HULL – BERTH POCKET DREDGING AND STONE BED INSTALLATION OPERATIONS

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that commencing on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2021 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) for a period of one month, berth pocket dredging and stone bed installation works will be conducted on the Western Approach Jetty at Alexandra Dock, Hull, as indicated on the diagram below.



The operation will be carried out by grab dredger “**HEIMDAL R**”, LOA 83m, beam 18.7m (callsign PCUO).

The first half of the combined works will be dredging works followed by the stone bed installation works.

Throughout the operation, surveys will be conducted regularly by survey vessel “**ELYSSE**” (MEHW5) operating in front of Alexandra Dock, Hull.

The “**HEIMDAL R**” and “**ELYSSE**” will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and, in addition, will keep a listening watch on VHF Channels 11, 12 and 16.

VTS will be contacted on commencement and completion of the works.

**MARINERS ARE WARNED** to exercise care and caution in the area and to pass “**HEIMDAL R**” and “**ELYSSE**” at a REDUCED SPEED to avoid creating a wash.
