INNER TRAFFIC SEPARATION SCHEME (OUTBOUND LANE) - SHOAL WATER

MARINERS ARE WARNED that a survey carried out on the 27th April 2023 shows the following: -

Depths of between 6.5 metres below Chart Datum and 7.3 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 400 metres into the Southern buoy-line of the Outward Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS) Lane in the vicinity of the No. 2 Haile Sand buoy.

Deeper water exists to the North in this vicinity.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED to navigate with caution in this area.
