

# **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

### No. H. 71/2025

## <u>RIVER HUMBER</u>

#### HULL ROADS – EAST MIDDLE - SHOAL WATER

**MARINERS ARE WARNED** that a survey carried out on the 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2025 shows the following: -

1) Depths of between 3.8 metres and 5.5 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 30 metres into the Northern edge of the channel from 390 metres downstream to 425 metres upstream of the No. 21 Hebbles Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the South in this vicinity.

2) Depths of between 4.9 metres and 5.5 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 56 metres into the Southern edge of the channel from 95 metres downstream to 480 metres upstream of the East Middle Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the North in this vicinity.

3) Depths of between 4.1 metres and 5.5 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 133 metres into the Southern edge of the channel from 711 metres upstream of the No. 22 Hook Light Buoy to 410 metres upstream of the No. 24 Lower West Middle Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the North in this vicinity.
