NEW SAND HOLE - SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Friday 26th July 2024 (or as soon as circumstances permit) for a period of approximately two weeks, seabed grab and geophysical survey works will be taking place around and within the New Sand Hole, Humber VTS traffic separation scheme.

The 26.5m survey vessel '**ISLA B**' (call sign MNVM2) will be engaged in the works and the operation will be undertaken 24 hours a day.

Whilst operating within the shipping lanes the '**ISLA B**' will maintain contact with VTS at all times to ensure that it does not impede traffic. The vessel will also exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED to navigate with caution in the area.
