AVAILABILITY OF ABP CHARTS FOR THE HUMBER

Shipmasters are reminded, that in order to comply with their obligation to facilitate the safe planning and monitoring of any passage, berth-to-berth; appropriate up-to-date charts for the area being transited should be carried.

In addition to the British Admiralty charts, the following charts, produced by Associated British Ports, are available for the Humber area which give more detail:-

Spurn to Barton Haven (Lower Humber) – produced annually.

Barton Haven to Burton Stather (Upper Humber) – produced every two months.

Burton Stather to Keadby (Lower Trent) – produced every six months.

Apex to Skelton Bridge (Lower Ouse) – produced every six months.
