DIVING OPERATIONS/REQUEST FOR PERMISSION TO DIVE

OWNERS, SHIP AGENTS, AND MASTERS are advised that diving activities carried out by third parties and other contractors in waters under ABP's jurisdiction, as defined in the Humber Navigation Byelaws 1990, byelaw 4, are SUBJECT to the agreement of the Harbour Master, Humber and shall be controlled by completion of the attached REQUEST FOR PERMISSION TO DIVE form.

Before any diving operations commence the Diving Supervisor will complete the checklist and inform VTS Humber on VHF Channel 12, 14 or 15 that the checklist has been completed and is available for inspection by any representative of Associated British Ports.

On completion of diving operations, VTS Humber must be informed and a copy of the checklist forwarded to the Harbour Master, Humber at Associated British Ports, Port House, PO Box 1, Northern Gateway, Hull, HU9 5PQ. Fax No 01482 218773.

This notice comes into effect from 9th July 2007.

Standing Notice to Mariners S.H. 37 dated 10th September 2001 issued by Associated British Ports will then be cancelled.
