GENERAL Associated British Ports is the Port Authority for the Port of Hull. King George Dock is staffed 24hrs; Alexandra and Albert Dock are staffed 4hrs to HW until 4hrs after HW by qualified Marine Staff who can be contacted at the marine control centres.

EMERGENCY ARRANGEMENTS

INCIDENT ABOARD SHIP In the event of an emergency requiring Police, Fire or Ambulance call the '**MARINE CONTROL CENTRE**' on 11 or 9, or '**VTS HUMBER**' on channel 16 or 12 stating the name of your vessel, the nature of the incident and the location of the Dock or Quay.

If no contact is possible by radio, dial '**999**' on the ship's cell phone.

In all cases **State** which emergency service you need, **Give** the vessel's name and berth and **Inform** Port Security. Keep a listening watch on any of the above VHF channels until emergency services arrive.

If the **Port Emergency Plan** is activated, VHF Ch 11 or 9 will be used for marine communications. A medical centre is situated at King George Dock (01482) 712113. Open 0830 - 1630 Monday - Friday.

INCIDENT ASHORE If a major emergency occurs within the port which may affect your vessel, you will be informed as soon as possible and advised of what to do.

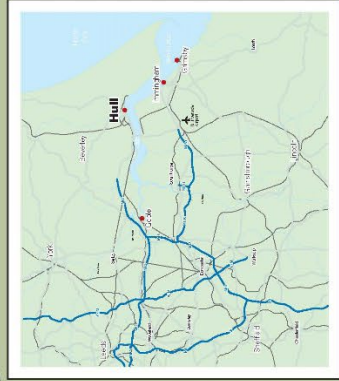
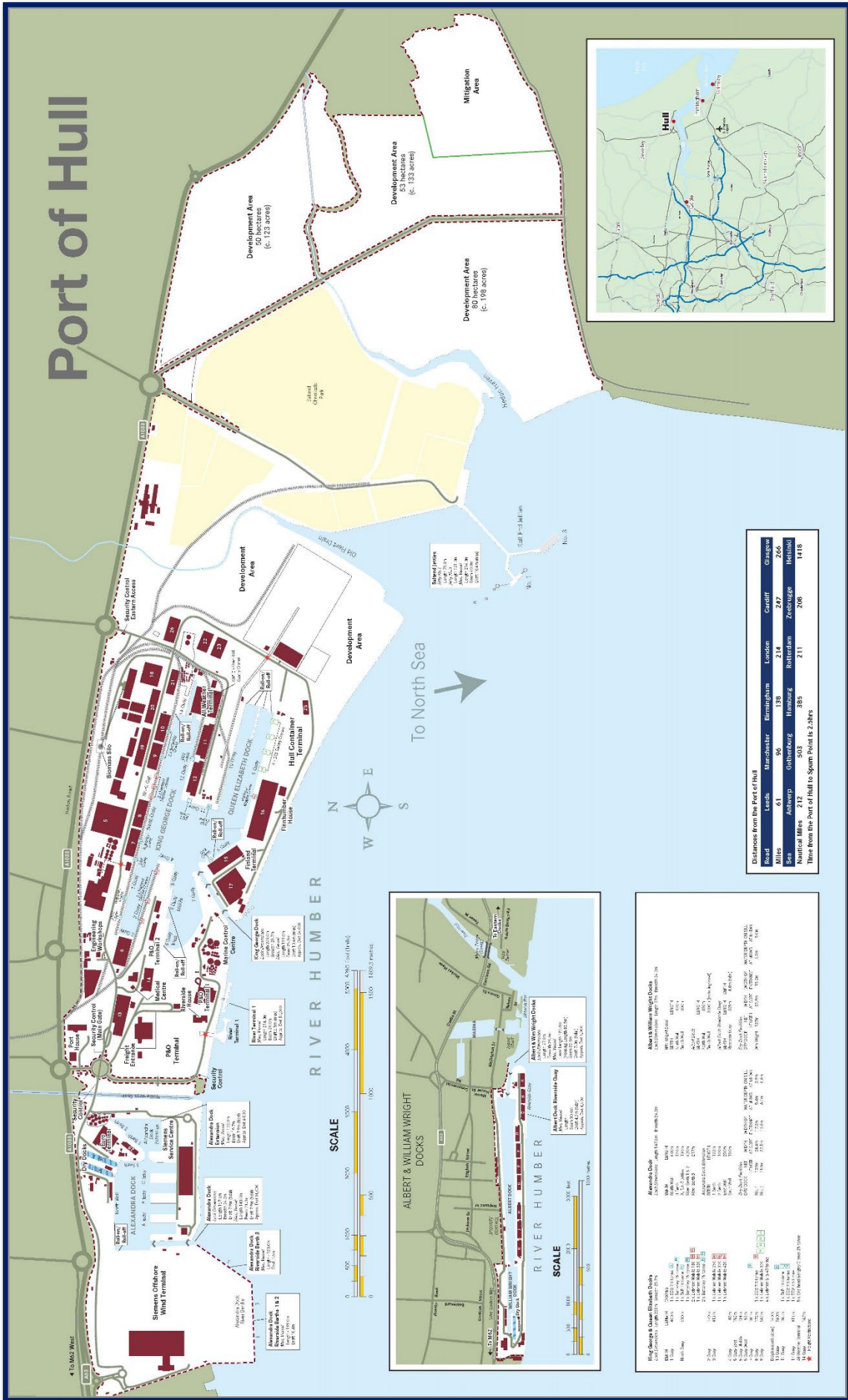
Be prepared to stop cargo operations, keep people indoors and/or move your ship. Keep a listening watch on VHF channel 11 or 9 until further notice.

You are required to immediately report to the Assistant Dock Master (ADM) any serious incident involving dangerous substances which might have caused serious personal injury or a risk to the safety of your vessel.

You must keep your vessel in a state of readiness to move at any time unless the ADM agrees otherwise.

Please note that if you are berthed at a Terminal not operated by ABP, the Terminal will have emergency arrangements in addition to those above.

Distance from the Port of Hull

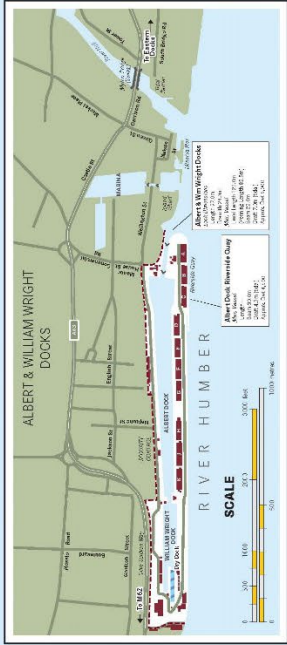
