NOTICE TO SHIP MASTERS

EMERGENCY ARRANGEMENTS

GENERAL Associated British Ports is the Port Authority for the Port of Immingham. The Immingham Marine Control Centre is staffed 24 hours by the Duty Assistant Dock Master and Radio Operator.

INCIDENT ABOARD SHIP In the event of an emergency requiring Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance, call 'MARINE CONRTOL CENTRE' on VHF Ch 68 or 19, or 'VTS HUMBER' on Channel 12 or 16, stating the name of your vessel, the nature of the incident, and the location of the Dock or Quay . If no contact is possible by radio, dial '999' on the ship's telephone.

In all cases **State** which emergency service you need, **Give** the vessel's name and berth, and **Inform** Port Security. Keep a listening watch on any of the above channels until emergency service arrives.

Any suspicious persons, items or activities should be reported immediately to the Marine Control Centre or Port Security.

If the **Port Emergency Plan** is activated Channel 68 will be used for marine communications.

INCIDENTS ASHORE If a major emergency occurs within the Port which may affect your vessel, you will be informed as soon as possible and advised what to do.


Be prepared to stop cargo operations, keep people indoors and/or move your ship. Keep a listening watch on VHF channel 68 until further notice.

You are required to report to the Assistant Dock Master (ADM) any serious incident involving dangerous substances which might have caused serious personal injury or a risk to the safety of your vessel.

You must keep your vessel in a state of readiness to move at any time unless the ADM agrees otherwise.

If you are berthed at a Terminal not operated by ABP, that the Terminal will have emergency arrangements in addition to those above.
